NDAEB Public Member

The National Dental Assisting Examining Board is accepting resumes and letters of interest for the position of the 'Public Member' director on our Board. To apply for the Public Member position, please email your information, including a letter of interest and a resume, to the NDAEB office by January 30th, 2022.

The Public Member represents the interests of the general public as a voting member of the Board. The office term term of office is for three (3) years, once renewable, for a total of six (6) years with Board approval. This is a volunteer position.

The Public Member shall not have a direct connection to dental assisting or any other dental profession, except as a consumer of dental services.

As a Board member, the Public Member is expected to attend Board meetings including at least one in-person meeting annually (subject to health restrictions). Other meetings may be convened, including periodic video-conference calls. The incumbent will be called upon to take part in committee work from time-to-time. Board members receive quarterly reports, including examination results and financial information.

The new Public Member will be invited to attend the next meeting of the Board following their election. The Directors do not receive remuneration for their work. All reasonable expenses related to travel, meals, accommodation and lost wages are covered by the NDAEB in keeping with NDAEB policy.
